Notes to the conductor:

1. The first movement contains *ad libitum* sections which should not be conducted in the normal sense. The beginning of each section should be indicated by a downbeat, shown by an arrow in the score, each section then being played as directed in the score at the discretion of the players. As a result of this form of scoring any vertical alignment in the score does not imply simultaneity of note playing.
2. In the third movement all the violins (i.e. violins 1 and 2) should be regarded as a complete section which is then divided, as equally as possible, into three sections.
3. In the third movement a triangular headed note denotes the playing of the highest note possible.
4. All the movements should be played without a break.
