Bar timings in the first section are given in seconds.

The unbarred section is loosely coordinated by the timeline in square brackets – timings (in seconds and minutes) are approximate, to be felt, not strictly adhered by, tending towards the expansive.

The hatched hairpin markings refer to increasing/decreasing intensity of bowing as much as dynamics (but not tempo).


About 30 to 45 seconds into the unbarred section the violinist and violist stand in their own time, and once all stood begin to very slowly rotate on the spot each as it were directing their sound outwards in space (this notion holds true too for the albeit stationary cellist).

About 5 minutes into this section the violinists and violist begin to slowly move out into the performing space each independently exploring facets of the acoustic they encounter.


