'Long After Tonight is All Over' was first performed by Jennifer Cohen on 14 November 2013 in the Sir Jack Lyons Concert Hall, University of York.

**'Long After Tonight is All Over'** is a short piece for solo flute. In it I wanted to explore the dark, fragile quality of the instrument's lowest register as the player explores a series of short fragments which move in and out of silence. A lyrical melody does briefly emerge but quickly subsides back into darkness.

The title is borrowed from the 'Northern Soul' classic by Jimmy Radcliffe, a favourite at Wigan Casino and one of the last songs played before the building was destroyed by fire.
