

There are seventy-two chords, played in order.

At the second chord, a single note changes.

At the third chord, two notes change.

At the fourth chord, a single note changes, and so on.

At each new chord, either three or four notes are sustained from the previous chord.

For ease of reading, new notes are indicated by filled noteheads.

Each chord lasts a different length, between 10-15 seconds., the timing of each at the discretion of the performer or decided upon by chance operations.

Playing time is 12-18 minutes.
