

Follow the basic pitch contours below as a guide for relative pitches of the notes.




The percussion clef used in combination with a five-line stave: It only indicates the approximate pitches of high, middle or low.



Usual rules of accidentals apply (i.e. they are only valid for all the notes of that pitch in that octave for the remaining duration of the bar).
