
1. WILLCOCK: CRUELITIES

NOTATION

The score is in C throughout.

Accidentals are: \sharp \times \flat \natural $\sharp\sharp$ \times $\flat\flat$ \natural $\sharp\sharp$ \times $\flat\flat$ \natural

Their effect continues up to the next bar line though repetitions are often marked for clarity.

 - indicates a continuous smooth glissando, the slide commencing at the beginning of the first note and ending at the start of the second. Unless indicated, there is no separate articulation of the second note. i.e. if it is a grace note it only serves to show the pitch reached at the end of the slide.

 - indicates an unmeasured trill. The trill interval is indicated by a second pitch in brackets. If there is no second pitch, the trill should be executed on one note by means of alternate fingerings. If there is a glissando associated with the trill, the trill interval remains constant (i.e. *both* pitches move).

An arrow linking two parameter values indicates a smooth progression between them.

VOICE

Unless indicated, absolutely no vibrato should be used.

-  - indicates a full (chest) voice with a normally open mouth and full projection.
-  - indicates a thin (head) voice, the mouth being partially closed. The effect should be extremely internal and intimate.

The sound material for the voice is partly notated using the symbols of the International Phonetic Association.

Material inside parentheses is given for guidance only and should not be performed.

OBOE/CLARINET

Unless approached via a glissando, quarter-tones should be fingered whenever possible.

-  - indicates a key-click.
-  - indicates a note composed entirely of breath.

VIOLA

Bowing positions are indicated on a five point scale notated above the staff:

- mst - molto sul tasto
- pst - poco sul tasto
- nat - normal
- psp - poco sul ponticello
- msp - molto sul ponticello

Pitch breakup, created by a combination of bow speed and pressure, is notated relative to a *normal* value. The absolute speed and pressure represented by this value will be dependent on dynamic and other variables at any particular instant.

-  - indicates a snap pizzicato.

PERCUSSION

The complete set of instruments required for the percussion part are:-

A vibraphone, 5 hub caps (producing different pitches), a sheet of heavy paper, a medium sized tin can (approximately 12cm diameter) open at one end, a tam-tam, a pedal bass-drum with two tom-toms mounted upon it, two floor tom-toms, a large bass drum mounted on its side, a small block of polystyrene and various beaters including a very heavy, soft beater for the tam-tam and large bass drum.

Beater types are indicated:

-  - very hard *rubber* mallets.
-  - (vibraphone/hub caps) medium soft vibraphone beaters.
-  - (tam-tam/large bass drum) very soft and heavy beater.
-  - metal triangle beater

When the vibraphone or tam tam are played with a triangle beater, the beater should be held *lightly* against the playing surface for the the indicated duration so that it is able to vibrate freely.

The large bass drum is played with the polystyrene block or finger by firmly rubbing the drum skin. The speed of movement is *inversely* proportional to the note duration so that the *distance* covered for each note is roughly the same (except for very short or very long notes).

The tin can is played by rattling a drum stick *inside* the can.

SOUND PROJECTION

All the instruments should be amplified except, possibly, for some of the percussion, depending upon the size of the performing area. The overall volume should be loud (but see the note for the voice in Refuge Song #1).

The tape starts are cued by means of short orientation tones *which should not be heard by the audience*. Some means of monitoring the tape other than through the main system is therefore indispensable. When the tape is stopped, its feed to the loudspeakers should be cut and it should be run forward and stopped precisely on the start of the next cue tone. When the point to start is reached in the score, the tape is started first and then its feed to the loudspeakers is restored.
