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The Text

PART ONE

CHORUS: When the time came he took his place at the table, and the apostles with him, and he said to them:

JESUS: "How I have longed to eat this Passover with you before my death! For I tell you, never again shall I eat it until the time when it finds its fulfilment in the kingdom of God."

CHORUS: Then he took a cup, and after giving thanks he said:

JESUS: "Take and share this among you; for I tell you, from this moment I shall drink no more from the fruit of the vine until the time when the kingdom of God comes."

CHORUS: And he took bread, gave thanks, and broke it; and he gave it to them with the words:

JESUS: "This is my body.
"Scripture says: He was counted among outlaws. These words must find fulfilment in me; indeed all that is written of me is being fulfilled."
