Refrains for Trombone and Tape

NOTES FOR PERFORMANCE

Stereo: Diffused through a multi-speaker system if possible Tape:

Trombone: Direct amplification and independent reverberation

> The level of direct (untreated) amplification should ensure that the trombone balances with the tape levels.

A reverberation unit with pre-programmable presets (for example: Yamaha, Lexicon) should be used with the following relative settings as indicated on the score.

PR-1 0.5 - 1 second

PR-2 2 seconds

PR-3 3 seconds

PR-4 3.5 - 4 seconds

These settings are to be taken as a guide and may be modified, depending on the performance space.

The reverberation is required to allow the notes in the trombone part to 'resonate.' Generally, the level of this treated sound should be less than the level of untreated amplified sound. At certain points, however, the resonances (the reverberation) must be prominent. They are:
