INSTRUCTIONS

DIVIDE THE GROUP IN TWO.
GROUP (A) SHOULD CONSIST OF PITCHED INSTRUMENTS/VOICES AND FREELY
INTERPRET GRID (A) TO COMPOSE THEIR MUSIC AND GROUP (B)
SHOULD CONSIST OF UNPITCHED INSTRUMENTS/VOICES AND FREELY
INTERPRET GRID (B).

GROUP A SHOULD COMPOSE A MELODIC LINE AND GROUP B A PHYTHMIC PATTERN.

EACH GROUP SHOULD ALSO COMPOSE A SHORT 'LOOP' FOR A SMALL NUMBER OF PERFORMERS (OF A SOLDIST) USING THE MIDDLE VENETICAL OF THEIR GRID-

AND KEEP REPEATING UNTIL THE END OF THE PIECE.

WHEN EACH GROUP HAS COMPOSED THERE MUSIC THEY SHOULD COME TOGETHER AND PERFORM SIMUTANEOUSLY AS ONE ENSEMBLE. FROM THIS POINT ON COMPOSE AND PERFORM AS ONE GROUP.

WHILST WRITING THE MUSIC CONSIDER UNRYING DYNAMICS, REPEATING FRAGMENTS AND ORCHESTRATING (SO THAT EVERY BODY ISNIT PLAYING ALL THE TIME).
