## Sing my day

## Performance notes

- 1. The texts are extrapolated from the Coventry Carol, Tomorrow will be my dancing day and the Irish folk-song She moved thro' the fair.
- 2. The tempo is only loosely indicated (crotchet = c. 92) for the very beginning of the carol. Thereafter the pulse can be modified (in either direction) as the singers think most appropriate from a technical and expressive point of view see point 3.
- 3. It is hoped that performers will be able to sing through to the end of each phrase without the need to re-breathe.
- 4. Dynamics are 'sketched in' rather than fixed. Performers should take care that this relative freedom does not result in an all-purpose *mezzoforte*.
- 5. Durations especially the 'trailing edges' should be observed with some care.
- 6.  $\Rightarrow$  = with mouth closed.
- 7. The absence of regular barlines/time signatures and the mixing of the three texts is intended to encourage a flexible, almost improvisatory manner of performance. To this end it might be appropriate for a 'ripienc' choir to sing the refrains whilst a much smaller 'concertino' group concern themselves with the intricacies of the verses.

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
