Programme note: There are three levels of narrative at work in *the boy the forest and the desert*: that of the narrator, who tells the story from the outside, that of the boy protagonist, who experiences it from the inside, and that of the offstage soprano, who in three songs presents a more abstracted commentary or response to the events. It's a very simple story: a boy walks into the woods in search of knowledge, but finds desecration where he hoped to find truth.
